RESOLUTION NO. 2017-9

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WRIGHTWOOD COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT ADOPTING A CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

WHEREAS, the Wrightwood Community Services District (Athe District@) is a community services district organized and operating pursuant to California Government Code Section 61000 et seq., and a local government agency subject to the requirements of the Political Reform Act of 1974 (Athe Act@), California Government Code Section 81000 et seq.;

WHEREAS, Section 87300 of the Act requires all local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes pursuant to the provisions of the Act;

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission (Athe FPPC@) has adopted a regulation, 2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code which can be incorporated by reference, and which may be amended by the FPPC after public notice and hearings to conform to amendments in the Act; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to comply with its statutory requirements under the Act and to provide a method to ensure that its Conflict of Interest Code is current and consistent with the prevailing provisions of the Act and the regulations of the FPPC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Wrightwood Community Services District as follows:

Section 1.

The terms of 2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 18730, and any amendments to it duly adopted by the FPPC, are hereby incorporated herein by this reference and, along with the attached Appendix in which members and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, shall constitute the District=s Conflict of Interest Code. In the event of any inconsistency between the attached Appendix and the prevailing provisions of the Act and/or the applicable regulations of the FPPC, the Act and the FPPC regulations shall control.

Section 2.

Designated officials shall file statements of economic interest with the District which will then be made available to the public for inspection and reproduction. Upon receipt of the statements from the District=s Board of Directors and General Manager, the Secretary of the District shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of said statements to the County Clerk of the County of San Bernardino and the County Clerk of the County of Los Angeles. Statements for all other designated officials will be retained by the District Secretary.

Section 3.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
